Looking for a spot to study or a place to set-up and participate in your online class? Below are a few places to check out!

Hartford Times Building (HTB) 10 Prospect Street

First Floor

- Zachs Atrium
- The Travelers Collaborative, off the Atrium
- Computer Stations – Computer Lab in HTB 143 is open for student use.
- Student Lounge
- Table Area outside of HTB 150
- Soft seating in hallway across courtyard from Atrium
- Any classroom when it is unoccupied—no class or special event scheduled on the screen

Second Floor

- The landing area above Student Services
- Lounge area – outside of the Interfaith and Reflection Space, HTB 230
- Soft seating areas tucked into the column and window areas above the Atrium
- Any classroom when it is unoccupied—no class or special event scheduled on the screen

Third Floor

- Quiet Study Rooms—available on a first-come, first-served basis—HTB 303A, 303B, 329, 330, 331 and 332
- Any classroom when it is unoccupied—no class or special event scheduled on the screen

Fifth Floor

- Classroom 508 – no class or special event scheduled on the screen
